Enclosed please find information on two scholarships the City of Dalhart will be awarding to 2012 graduating seniors. Each scholarship is for \$2,000 (\$500 each semester for a maximum of three years). An applicant may apply for one or both of these scholarships.

To be eligible an applicant must:

- Have graduated from a high school located in Dallam or Hartley County.
- Have continuously resided in Dallam or Hartley County for the past two (2) years prior to application.
- Be able to fulfill all requirements as noted in the guidelines and application forms. SAT or ACT score must be included.

The scholarships are available for college/university or technical training.

As part of the application process, a 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid Report must be completed. This report may take as long as six (6) weeks to completely process so students desiring to apply should start now on their applications.

The deadline for submitting the application and all supporting documents is April 27, 2012. **Please stress the need to fill out the FAFSA and send in immediately,** as this report is an integral part of the process, and applications received without this report will not be considered.

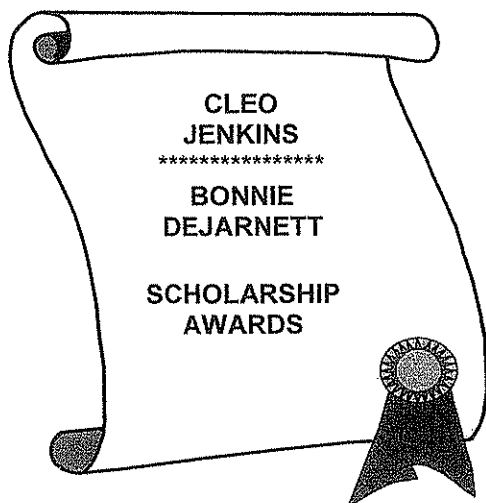

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Administered by: City of Dalhart, Texas

STATED PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Scholarship is to provide post-secondary awards to residents of the Dalhart, Texas area in order that they may more fully develop their talents.



The Scholarship Board has the final authority in the selection of recipients to be presented to the Dalhart City Council for consideration.

Each scholarship recipient will normally be notified in the month of May. Each scholarship will be reviewed each semester/term to verify that the recipient has fulfilled his/her obligation for continuation.

The amount of the scholarship will be determined each year by the Scholarship Board and is limited to a maximum period of three (3) years. The amount of the scholarship for a full-time student attending technical school or training shall also be determined by the Scholarship Board.

The scholarship amount must be used to help defray expenses for the following items: tuition; required fees, required textbooks and instructional supplies required by the course of study; and room/ board.

Scholarship payments will be sent directly to the recipient upon proof of enrollment in the approved/accredited program. Scholarship payments will normally be made in August and January of each school year. The check will be made jointly, payable to the recipient and the educational institution.

A scholarship applicant must:

- ✓ Have graduated from a high school located in Dallam or Hartley County; and
- ✓ Have continuously resided in Dallam or Hartley County for the past two years prior to application; and
- ✓ Fulfill all requirements as noted in the guidelines and the application forms.

The scholarship awards shall be available for college, university or technical school training.

All applicants, *except those attending technical schools*, must have taken the ACT test.

Each recipient must attend an approved college, university or technical school.

In order to continue to receive the scholarship award:

- **Recipients must have received a passing average for the previous semester; a passing average (grade of 'C' (2.0 GPA) or its equivalent) as**

determined by the particular college, university or technical school.

- Proof of enrollment and grades earned must be given to the Scholarship Board each semester. Scholarships will be terminated if we do not hear from a student for more than one semester.
- The recipient must continually maintain a full-time student status at the school. Students must complete and pass 12 hours or more each semester in order to maintain the scholarship. The Scholarship Board reserves the right to revoke a scholarship award for cause.

Recipients shall be selected by the Scholarship Board based on the following areas:

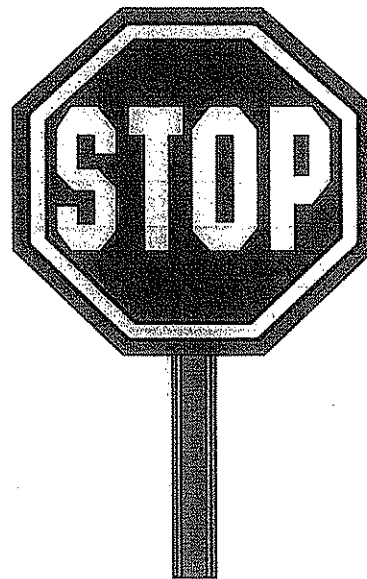
1. Proven/estimated ability
2. Citizenship
3. Financial need
4. Leadership
5. Willingness to work

Recipients are **not eligible** to re-apply for an additional scholarship after completion or due to termination of the scholarship award. Recipients must notify the Scholarship Board if they transfer from one school to another.

Upon special approval by the Scholarship Board, a designated portion of the scholarship award may be used for summer study.

Each applicant is considered on his/her own individual merits.

In consideration of the best interests of an applicant and the Dalhart community, the Scholarship Board may modify these guidelines.



IMPORTANT NOTE

The following items must be submitted with application. Those received with incomplete information will not be considered.

- Completed Application
- **Complete** copy of current year Federal Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Official high school transcript showing grade point average and ACT scores
- Copy of college transcript (if applicable)
- Letter of recommendation
- Typewritten narrative of school and career plans

PLEASE FURNISH THE FOLLOWING:

1. A complete official transcript of your high school record, indicating your grade average through the last semester completed; or a copy of your GED Certificate.
2. A copy of your ACT test scores.
3. A letter of recommendation from your high school principal, teacher, and/or counselor or if in college, recommendation from a college professor or counselor.
4. In two pages or less double spaced, submit a typewritten narrative indicating your college or technical school plans. This statement should include at least the following but is not limited to the following:
 - What is your planned major?
 - Why did you choose this field of study?
 - What do you plan to do career-wise?
 - What are your goals or future expectations?
5. A complete copy of your 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid Report (FAFSA). This report must be received by the Scholarship Board, along with your application **NO LATER THAN 5:00 P.M., APRIL 27, 2012.**

FAFSA statement reports may take as long as six weeks to completely process. You **must file your FAFSA request early in order to meet the April 27 deadline. The report must include the *EFC Number (Expected Family Contribution)* and must be printed with the name and/or social security number on the same page. If the internet printout does not have the name and *EFC Number* on the same page, it is **unacceptable**. You must then obtain a paper SAR by calling the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 800-433-3243 or 319-337-5665, or by e-mail at sfamail@ncs.ed.gov. You can also write to Student Financial Assistance, P.O. Box 84, Washington, DC 20044.**

The 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) packet is available from your high school counselor.

Recipient applications will be selected by the Scholarship Board and presented to the Dalhart City Council for approval.

Applications must be submitted to the Dalhart City Manager's Officer no later than April 27, 2012. The mailing address is P.O. Box 2005, Dalhart, Texas 79022.

If you are using the online FAFSA application and report, you must request the paper SAR to submit with your Scholarship application. Students can request a paper SAR by calling the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 800-4-FED-AID (800-433-3243) or 319-337-5665 between 8:00 a.m. and midnight (eastern time) Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturday, or by e-mail at sfamail@ncs.ed.gov. The paper SAR may also be requested by writing to Student Financial Assistance, P.O. Box 84, Washington, DC 20044. Make sure to include the student's name, date of birth, complete address, Social Security Number and award year on all correspondence.
